'One Course' walk. 45 minutes






Explore our idyllic riverside village with this 'one course' walk.

Exploring Orford and the surrounding area

We're all about delicious food. In order to make your stay more comfortable, we've put together a selection of walks you may enjoy during your stay. Whether you've had one course or four, there's a suitable route for all.

Two course - 2 miles - 1 hour

Follow the road past Orford castle, on to open farmland and back round into the village. Watch out for the piglets!

Three course - 5 miles - 2 hours

Heading north to the village of Sudbourne. Back through the woods, past the 12th century All Saints Church and into Sudbourne park, before walking back into Orford.

Four course - 7 miles - 3.5 hours

Walk towards the quay, following along the river wall to Butley Ferry. Find out where Pinney's smokehouse actually is and see if you can spot any of the scenes from The Dig! Then head back into the village.

If you are feeling a little more adventurous, why not try our 5 course walk? With an approximate length of 7.5 hours, it's not for the faint of heart! It will take you along the river edge, past open farmland and through the woods, back into the village.
